## MID-MISSOURI 2020 OPIOID SUMMIT

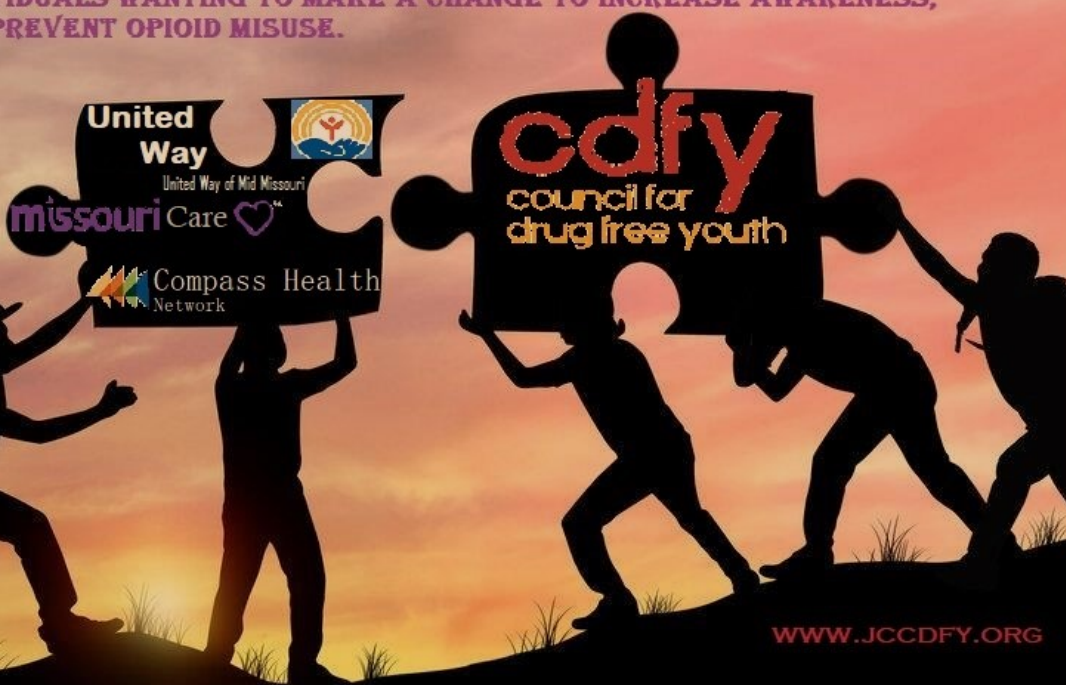

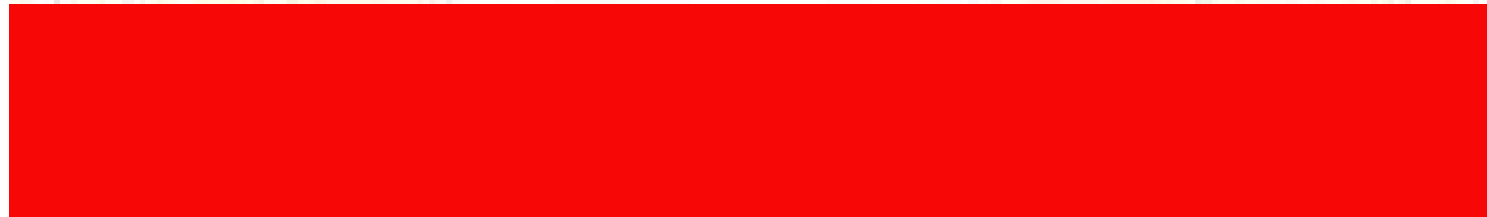
**Coalition Meeting ~ June 11**
